

for any [goods] SUPPLIES manufactured by a company whose name appears on the most recent list of the Secretary OF GENERAL SERVICES.

(c) This restriction does not prohibit the awarding of a contract to a company whose name does not appear on such a list but whose [goods] SUPPLIES manufactured include component parts manufactured by a company whose name does appear on the list.

(d) This restriction does not apply during an emergency situation when the listed person is the sole source of [supply for the goods] SUPPLIES or services.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 16D and 7A, respectively, of Article 78A - Public Works, of the Annotated Code of Maryland be and they are hereby transferred, with amendments, to be Section(s) 3-405 and 3-406, respectively, of the new Article 21 - Procurement, of the Annotated Code of Maryland, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 21 - PROCUREMENT

[16D.] 3-405.

(a) For the purposes of this [subtitle] SECTION:

(1) A reference to the "State" or a "subdivision" shall include any bicoounty or multicounty governmental agency located within the State; and

(2) The word "conviction" shall include an accepted plea of nolo contendere.

(b) Any person convicted under the provisions of Article 27 of the Annotated Code, of bribery, attempted bribery or conspiracy to bribe based upon acts committed after July 1, 1977 in furtherance of obtaining a contract with the State or any of its subdivisions, shall be disqualified from entering into a contract with the State, or any county or other subdivision of the State[, for the supply of goods or services by the person].

(c) A person not disqualified under the provisions of subsection (b) who (1) has been convicted under the provisions of Article 27 of the Annotated Code, of bribery, attempted bribery, or conspiracy to bribe, (2) during the course of an official investigation or other proceeding has admitted, in writing or under oath, acts or omissions which would constitute bribery, attempted bribery, or conspiracy to bribe under the provisions of that article, or (3) has been convicted under the laws of another state or the federal government of bribery, attempted bribery, or conspiracy to bribe, shall be subject to disqualification, pursuant to the procedure hereinafter established, from entering into a contract with the State, or any county or
