- (i) The Secretary, ex officio, or his
 designee;
- (ii) One member appointed from the Department by the Governor on recommendation of the Secretary, which member serves at the pleasure of the Governor; and
- (iii) Two members appointed from the general public by the Governor, at least one of whom is not an architect or engineer and each of whom serves a term of 4 years and until his successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (2) On recommendation of the Secretary, the Governor may appoint an alternate member to serve in the absence of the regular member appointed under this subsection from the Department.
- (c) The head of the using authority that is presenting a request to the <u>GENERAL SELECTION</u> Board shall be a temporary member of the <u>GENERAL SELECTION</u> Board. The temporary member serves only for the purposes of considering and acting on the request of the using authority by which he is appointed.

- (a) The members of the GENERAL SELECTION Board may be removed by the Governor for misconduct, incompetency, neglect of duty, or other sufficient cause.
- (b) A permanent member appointed to fill a vacancy in an unexpired term serves only for the remainder of that term.
- (c) A member of the GENERAL SELECTION Board may not participate in any matter before the GENERAL SELECTION Board in which:
 - (1) The member has an interest; or
- (2) Any other person, other than a using authority, has an interest, if the member is or within the previous 12 months has been associated with the other person.

- (a) The <u>GENERAL SELECTION</u> Board shall adopt rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of this subtitle
- (b) The rules and regulations adopted by the <u>GENERAL</u> <u>SELECTION</u> Board under this section and those adopted by the <u>Transportation Professional Services Selection Board under § [2-305] 9-105 of [the Transportation Article] THIS ARTICLE shall provide for substantially the same procedures.</u>
