- (a) A using authority that desires to procure architectural or engineering services costing over \$25,000 shall present the request to the GENERAL SELECTION Board at a public meeting.
- (b) Reasonable and timely public notice shall be given of any request presented to the GENERAL SELECTION Board.
- (c) Before the <u>GENERAL SELECTION</u> Board approves any request for architectural or engineering services, it shall be satisfied that the services cannot be provided feasibly or economically by existing in-house resources.

- (a) (1) The <u>GENERAL SELECTION</u> Board shall require uniform and consistent public announcements of all its approvals of requests for the procurement of architectural or engineering services.
- (2) In addition, an announcement of the approval of each request shall be mailed to each person that requests notification.

- (1) Describe generally the architectural and engineering services to be procured; and
- (2) Indicate how interested persons may receive information about the procurement.
