suitable evidence, the proceeds of the loan shall be expended in accordance with the provisions of this Act. If satisfactory evidence of the raising of at least an equal and matching fund for this project is not presented to the Board of Public Works on or before June 1, [1980] 1982, the proceeds of the loan shall be transferred to the Annuity Bond Fund and applied to the debt service requirements of the State.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1980.

(House Bill 1305)

AN ACT concerning

Private Detectives - Insurance Adjuster Exception

FOR the purpose of exempting independent insurance adjusters from requirements of private detective licensing; and making stylistic changes.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 56 - Licenses

75.

(a) The term "private detective business" means the business of conducting a private detective agency or for the purpose of making for hire or reward any investigation or investigations for the purpose of obtaining information with reference to any of the following matters, notwithstanding the fact that other functions and services may also be performed by the same person, firm, association or corporation for fee, hire, or reward, to wit: (1) crime or wrong done or threatened or assumed to have been done or threatened against the government of the United States of America, or any state, territory, or possession of the
