(3)--FERTILIZER, SEEDS, ANNUAL PLANTS, ANY FORM OF ANIMAL FEED, LIFE, AND ANIMAL FEED SOLD FOR RESALE OR USE IN THE AGRICULTURAL FOOD INDUSTRY.

(P)--"VEHICLE"--MEANS EVERY DEVICE CAPABLE OF BEING MOVED UPON A PUBLIC HIGHWAY AND IN, UPON, OR BY WHICH ANY PERSON OR PROPERTY IS OR MAY BE TRANSPORTED OR DRAWN UPON A PUBLIC HIGHWAY, EXCEPTING DEVICES MOVED BY HUMAN OR ANIMAL POWER OR FIXED EXCLUSIVELY UPON STATIONARY RAILS OR TRACKS.

(Q)--"WASTE"--MEANS BY-PRODUCTS GENERATED BY THE PUBLIC IN THE CONSUMPTION OF GOODS AND PRODUCTS PURCHASED AT RETAIL.

(R)--"WATERCRAFT"--MEANS ANY BOAT, SHIP, VESSEL, BARGE, OR OTHER FLOATING CRAFT.

(S)--"WHOLESALE"--MEANS ANY PERSON ENGAGED IN A BUSINESS ACTIVITY OF SELLING TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY OTHER THAN WHOLLY BY MEANS OF SALES AT RETAIL.

THE DEPARTMENT HAS OVERALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE RESOURCE RECOVERY AND MATERIALS RECYCLING PROGRAM BUT SHALL CONSULT WITH AND ASSIGN SPECIFIC PROGRAM FUNCTIONS AS PROVIDED FOR IN THE PREAMBLE TO THE ACTS THAT ESTABLISHED THE MARYLAND ENVIRONMENTAL TRUST AND THE MARYLAND ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES CORPORATION.

(A)--THERE IS A RESOURCE RECOVERY AND MATERIALS RECYCLING FUND CREATED WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT TO ASSIST WITH PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT AND MONITORING RELATING TO EFFECTIVE MANAGEMENT OF SOLID WASTE IN THIS STATE.

(B)--ALL ASSESSMENTS, FINES, APPROPRIATIONS, OR OTHER FUNDS COLLECTED OR RECOVERED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE OR APPROPRIATED TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR THIS PURPOSE SHALL BE:

(1)--DEPOSITED IN THE FUND;

(2)--USED FOR THE PURPOSES SET OUT IN THIS SUBTITLE AND

(3)--ADMINISTERED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET.
