

(C)--THE FUND SHALL BE USED FOR RESOURCE RECOVERY AND MATERIALS RECYCLING, INCLUDING ADMINISTRATION, PERSONNEL, EQUIPMENT, RESOURCE RECOVERY, AND MATERIAL RECYCLING STUDIES, APPLIED PROJECTS AND DEMONSTRATIONS, MONITORING OF PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS, MARKETING OF RECOVERED MATERIALS, AND TRAINING RELATED TO THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND.

(D)--THE AMOUNT IN THE FUND NOT COMMITTED TO A SPECIFIC PROGRAM OR PROJECT SHALL BE LIMITED TO \$1,000,000 IN ANY ONE YEAR. THE BALANCE OF THE AMOUNT IN THE FUND SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED TO A SUBDIVISION IN THIS STATE ON THE PRORATED BASIS OF THE COLLECTIONS FROM THE SUBDIVISION.

(A)--A RESOURCE RECOVERY ADVISORY BOARD IS CREATED WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT.

(B)--THE BOARD CONSISTS OF 15 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR TO REPRESENT VARIOUS INTERESTS ASSOCIATED WITH RESOURCE RECOVERY AND WASTE DISPOSAL.

(C)--(1)--OF THE 15 MEMBERS, FOUR SHALL BE RECOMMENDED BY THE FOLLOWING STATE SECRETARIES:

(i)--ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT;

(ii)--ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE;

(iii)--ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE PLANNING, AND

(iv)--ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE SECRETARY OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

(2)--OF THE 15 MEMBERS, 11 SHALL REPRESENT THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

(3)--AT LEAST ONE EACH OF FIVE OF THE 11 MEMBERS SHALL RESIDE IN THE FOLLOWING GEOGRAPHICAL AREAS:

(i)--THE REGIONAL PLANNING COUNCIL;

(ii)--THE DELMARVA ADVISORY COUNCIL;

(iii)--THE TRICOUNTY COUNCIL FOR SOUTHERN MARYLAND;

(iv)--THE TRICOUNTY COUNCIL FOR WESTERN MARYLAND, AND

(v)--THE MARYLAND JURISDICTIONS IN THE COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS.

(D)--THE BOARD SHALL ELECT ONE OF THE PUBLIC MEMBERS AS CHAIRMAN.
