- (C) THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF OCEAN CITY SHALL:
- (1) KEEP RECORDS AS ARE CONSISTENT WITH SOUND BUSINESS PRACTICE;
- (2) CAUSE AN AUDIT TO BE MADE OF ITS ACCOUNTING AT THE CONCLUSION OF EACH CALENDAR OR FISCAL YEAR; AND
- (3) SUBMIT A DETAILED ANNUAL REPORT OF THE ACTIVITIES AND FINANCIAL STANDING OF THE CONVENTION HALL TO THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS.
- (D) THE CONVENTION HALL IS EXEMPT FROM TAXATION BY THE STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS.
- (E)--THE-TITLE-TO-THE-OCEAN--CITY--CONVENTION--HALL--IS HELD-BY-THE-STATE-OF-MARYLAND-
- (E) AS A CONDITION FOR THE ADMINISTRATION AND MANAGEMENT OF THE CONVENTION HALL, THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF OCEAN CITY SHALL ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE STATE OF MARYLAND ACCEPTING TITLE TO THE CONVENTION HALL AS OF JULY 1, 1985.
