CONTRACT WITH THE SCHOOL OR COLLEGE OR ITS DESIGNATED CONTRACTING AGENT, BUT NOT INCLUDING SALES AT EVENTS WHICH ARE NOT SPONSORED BY THE SCHOOL OR COLLEGE OR ARE NOT EDUCATIONALLY RELATED; AND

(III) AT HOSPITALS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.

CHAPTER 823

(Senate Bill 222)

AN ACT concerning

Competency to Stand Trial and Responsibility for Criminal Conduct
