

change in the method of operation, the [State Board of Health shall be empowered to] DEPARTMENT MAY issue an order requiring the owner of the system or plant to make [such] alterations or extensions to the system or plant, or to install [such] A new system or plant, as the Board DEPARTMENT [may determine] DETERMINES necessary to correct improper conditions. The [State Board of Health] DEPARTMENT shall name in its order [such] THE date for the completion of the work as it [may deem] CONSIDERS reasonable and proper.

(B) THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE MAY AUTHORIZE A LOCAL HEALTH OFFICER TO:

(1) CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OF REFUSE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS; AND

(2) ENFORCE STATE REGULATIONS GOVERNING SUCH SYSTEMS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.
