resident who determines that he does not wish to sign the rental agreement shall give to the park owner notice of an intent to vacate. The notice may be, at the discretion of the resident, for a period of not more than 60 days after the 60-day consideration period and, during this period a park owner may not terminate the tenancy or institute an eviction proceeding except for cause under this Act.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.

CHAPTER 844

(Senate Bill 1079)

AN ACT concerning

State Lottery Commission - Appeals

FOR the purpose of granting the Lottery Commission the power to hear and decide an appeal and-review-any-decision-of the-Lottery-Director-to-license-a-lottery-agent of any denial by the Lottery Director of the licensing of a lottery agent.

BY adding to

Article 88D - State Lottery Section 7(h) Annotated Code of Maryland (1979 Replacement Volume and 1979 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 88D - State Lottery

(H)--TO-HEAR-AN-APPEAL-AND-REVIEW-ANY-DEGISION--OF--THE DIRECTOR--TO--LICENSE-A-LOTTERY-ACENT-PURSUANT-TO-SUBSECTION

(H) TO HEAR AND DECIDE AN APPEAL OF ANY DENIAL BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE LICENSING OF A LOTTERY AGENT PURSUANT TO TO HEAR AND DECIDE AN APPEAL OF ANY DENIAL BY THE SUBSECTION 8(E) OF THIS ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.
