(E) THE SOCIAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION MAY CONTRACT WITH PRIVATE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS TO ASSIST ~~IN THE OPERATION OF~~ OPERATE THE PROGRAM.

(F) THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE SHALL GIVE PRIORITY ACCESS, AS APPROPRIATE, TO WOMEN EVALUATED BY THE SHELTER HOME TO INSTITUTIONS UNDER ITS SUPERVISION AND SHALL SUPPLY APPROPRIATE MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES.

(G) THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE SHALL NOT USE THIS SHELTER AS PART OF THEIR DISCHARGE SERVICE PLAN.

(H) HOUSING MAY NOT BE PROVIDED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE TO APPLICANTS FOR HOUSING WHO ARE NOT RESIDENTS OF MARYLAND AT THE TIME APPLICATION FOR HOUSING IS MADE.

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(A) FUNDS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF THE MODEL SHELTER HOME SHALL BE AS PROVIDED IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET.

(B) THE SECRETARY OF HUMAN RESOURCES SHALL BY RULE AND REGULATION SET CHARGES FOR SERVICES RENDERED BY THE MODEL SHELTER HOME.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.
