- ALCOHOLISM (3) 60 OUTPATIENT VISITS AT A CERTIFIED TRANSPORT FACILITY. BENEFITS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPHS (1) AND (2) MAY BE LIMITED TO 111 DAYS OF ACTIVE INPATIENT TREATMENT IN THE COVERED PERSON'S LIFETIME.
- (B) ANY MAJOR MEDICAL CONTRACT, POLICY OR CERTIFICATE, INCLUDING ONE ISSUED BY A NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN, THAT PROVIDES BENEFITS FOR BOTH HOSPITALIZATION AND MEDICAL CARE SHALL PROVIDE BENEFITS EQUAL TO AT LEAST HALF THOSE REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION
- (C) THE MAXIMUM BENEFIT, UNDER THIS SECTION, IN THE AGGREGATE DURING ANY CALENDAR YEAR OR BENEFIT PERIOD MAY BE LIMITED TO NOT LESS THAN \$1,000.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July-17-1989 January 1, 1981.

(House Bill 969)
