council, as the case may be, prior to the acquisition, construction, leasing, installation or material extension of a project in a county and providing that the Authority shall not acquire, construct, lease, install or materially extend such project, if the board of county commissioners, city council or county council, as the case may be, finds that such project would be contrary to the best interests of the residents of such county; providing that this Act shall become null and void under certain conditions; providing that judicial review shall include the right to appeal to the Court of Special Appeals and the Court of Appeals; providing for the merger of the Authority into the Maryland Environmental Service under certain conditions; and relating generally to the creation, powers, and duties of the Northeast Maryland Waste Disposal Authority.
