Officials of a civic organization that acts as a governing
body of a special taxing district are usually not protected.

To protect the integrity of citizen involvement with government and to encourage volunteer efforts, it is important to examine the circumstances and events which contribute to this phenomenon and to identify actions which will alleviate the problem.

(2) TWO MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES, APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER;

(3) TWO MEMBERS OF THE SENATE, TO BE APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT;

(4) A REPRESENTATIVE DESIGNEE OF THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES;

(5) A REPRESENTATIVE DESIGNEE OF THE MARYLAND MUNICIPAL LEAGUE;

(6) A REPRESENTATIVE DESIGNEE FROM THE MARYLAND TECHNICAL ADVISORY SERVICE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND;

(7) A DESIGNEE FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE;

(8) A REPRESENTATIVE DESIGNEE OF THE MARYLAND STATE BAR ASSOCIATION;

(9) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE INSURANCE COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE; AND
