Preamble

~~WHEREAS, The General Assembly finds that physical violence inflicted by people against their spouses and household members is prevalent at all levels of society, and~~

~~WHEREAS, Not only are these intrafamily assaults physically injurious to the victim, but the reliance on violence as a means of resolving domestic disputes produces marital disharmony and promotes an emotional atmosphere conducive to unhealthy childhood development, and~~

~~WHEREAS, The remedies available to the victim of an intrafamily assault need to be expanded to include a civil remedy providing immediate and effective protection, now, therefore,~~
