This bill establishes the annual appropriation for Program Open Space for fiscal year 1980.

House Bill 931, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on April 8, 1980 accomplishes the same purpose.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign Senate Bill 443.
