This bill authorizes the Industrial Land Loan of 1980 in the aggregate amount of \$3,000,000.

House Bill 926, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 27, 1980 accomplishes the same purpose.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign Senate Bill 562.
