Senate Bill No. 618

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Somerset County Jail

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State debt in the amount of \$1,000,000 \$1,500,000, the proceeds to be used to assist in the construction and equipping of a Somerset County Jail Facility, subject to the provision by the County Commissioners of Somerset County of at least an equal and matching fund for the same purpose; and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.
