This bill prescribes a form to be used to advise persons of certain decisions of juvenile intake officers.

House Bill 1976, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 20, 1980 accomplishes the same purpose.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign Senate Bill 1017.
