Senate Bill No. 1032

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Cecil
County Jail

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$2,500,000, the proceeds to be used to assist in the planning, design, construction, and equipping of a new Cecil County jail facility, subject to the condition that the Cecil County Commissioners provide at least an equal and matching fund for the same purpose by a certain date; and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 1032.

This bill authorizes a State debt to be used to assist in the planning, design, construction and equipping of a new Cecil County jail facility.

House Bill 1517, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 27, 1980 accomplishes the same purpose.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign Senate Bill 1032.
