In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 671.

This bill provides that weight and speed limitation signs on bridges and culverts shall be worded in accordance with the standards in the manual on uniform traffic control devices.

House Bill 599, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed be me on May 6, 1980 accomplishes the same purpose.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign House Bill 671.
