

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, That, any transaction affected by or flowing from any statute here amended, repealed, or transferred, and validly entered into before the effective date of this Order and every right, duty, or interest flowing from such a transaction it remains valid after the effective date and may be terminated, completed, consummated, or enforced pursuant to law.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, That any unexpended appropriation for the purpose of financing the Office of Minority Business Enterprise shall be transferred by approved budget amendment to the Executive Department - Office of the Governor.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, That, unless specifically disapproved, within 50 days after submission, by a resolution of disapproval concurred in by a majority vote of all members of either House of the General Assembly, this Executive Order shall take effect.
