The Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene shall have such authority and powers over the departments and other units herein enumerated as are or shall be from time to time specifically granted by law. All authority and powers not so granted to the Secretary are reserved to the departments or other units free of the Secretary's control.

Article 43 - Health

1F. Powers and duties of Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene.

The jurisdiction, powers and duties of the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene are as follows:

I. FOR THOSE ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATORY FUNCTIONS OF THE SECRETARY OF NATURAL RESOURCES OR THE DIRECTOR OF THE WATER RESOURCES ADMINISTRATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES TRANSFERRED TO THE SECRETARY BY EXECUTIVE ORDER (1980) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADMINISTER AND ENFORCE THOSE FUNCTIONS SO AS TO ENSURE THE PRESERVATION, CONSERVATION, ENHANCEMENT, WISE USE, AND PERPETUATION OF THE NATURAL RESOURCES OF THE STATE FOR THE GREATEST BENEFIT TO THE STATE AND ITS CITIZENS.
