Resolution of the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis, adopted pursuant to the authority of Article 11-E of the Constitution of the State of Maryland and Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1973 Replacement Volume and Supplements), titled "Corporations-Municipal", to repeal and re-enact Section 38 of the Charter of the City of Annapolis for the purpose of adding certain criteria which the Port Wardens shall consider when granting wharves and related construction in the waterways and Port, namely the effect said construction will have on boats and the use of boats; re-enacting all other provisions of Section 38 not inconsistent with this amendment; and all matters relating generally thereto.
