# COLLEGE PARK

## RESOLUTION NO. 79-CR-1

A resolution to repeal and reenact Section 40 of Article XI of the College Park Charter pertaining to enforcement of ordinances in order to designate violations of City Ordinances as municipal infractions that are civil in nature rather than criminal, while at the same time retaining the right to designate other violations as criminal misdemeanors.

WHEREAS, Section III of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland permits municipalities to provide that violations of ordinances are municipal infractions unless the violation is declared to be a felony or a misdemeanor by law or ordinance.
