Council of the Town of Manchester to enlarge the corporate boundaries of said Town by the annexation of a parcel of land contiguous to and adjoining the existing corporate boundaries of said Town; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have caused to be made a verification of the signatures upon said Petition and have ascertained that the persons signing the Petition represent at least Twenty-five percent (25%) of the persons who reside in the area to be annexed or who are registered voters in County elections in the precinct in which the territory to be annexed is located and the owners of at least Twenty-five percent (25%) of the assessed valuation of the real property located in the area to be annexed;
