AN ACT to provide for the extension of the Plan In Progress legislation, by repealing Section 22-16, Article II. Planning, title "Planning, Zoning and Subdivision Control", of the Baltimore County Code, 1978, and enacting a new Section 22-16 in lieu thereof under said article, title and code, said new section to be known as the Plan in Progress Act, which plan and legislation have already been the subject of extensive public hearings, reports and recommendations by the Planning Board of Baltimore County.

WHEREAS, the County is and has been diligently pursuing the development and adoption of a new Comprehensive Master Plan and implementing growth management legislation, which is a complex, difficult and time consuming effort which has involved extensive staff, consultant, citizen and official input and involvement; and
