AN ACT for the purpose of providing a method to establish and fund the expenses of a Middle Patuxent Sewer Interceptor Project by (1) adding new Section 18.101.1 "Middle Patuxent Drainage Area Subdistrict" to Title 18 "Public Works", Subtitle 1 "Public Utilities" creating the Middle Patuxent Drainage Area Subdistrict within the Metropolitan District and defining the area of the Subdistrict; and (2) adding new Section 20.311 B "Middle Patuxent Drainage Area Assessments, Charges and Taxes" to Title 20 "Taxation and Public Credit", Subtitle 3 "Water and Sewer Charges and Assessments" providing for Middle Patuxent Drainage supplemental in-aid-of construction charges and Middle Patuxent Drainage Area supplemental ad valorem taxes and establishing the charges and the ad valorem tax.
