AN ACT to repeal and reenact with amendments Section 2-25, title, "Composition and functions of Office of the Chief Administrative Officer", of Article III, title "Executive Branch," of Chapter 2, title "Administration"; and Section 11-2, title "Office of Consumer Affairs" of Chapter 11, title "Consumer Protection"; of the Montgomery County Code 1972, as amended, to establish as principal offices in the Executive Branch an Office of Personnel and a Budget and Research Office under the immediate direction
