

(B) DISPLAY.

EACH LICENSEE SHALL DISPLAY THE LICENSE CONSPICUOUSLY AT THE LICENSEE'S PLACE OF BUSINESS.

11-211. CHANGE OF PLACE OF BUSINESS.

(A) CONSENT REQUIRED.

A LICENSEE MAY NOT CHANGE THE PLACE OF BUSINESS FOR WHICH A LICENSE IS ISSUED UNLESS THE LICENSEE:

(1) ~~NOTIFIES~~ SENDS THE COMMISSIONER ~~IN WRITING~~ THE LICENSE AND WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED CHANGE; AND

(2) RECEIVES THE WRITTEN CONSENT OF THE COMMISSIONER.

(B) ATTACHMENT OF CONSENT.

IF THE COMMISSIONER CONSENTS TO A PROPOSED CHANGE OF PLACE OF BUSINESS, ~~THE LICENSEE~~ THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ATTACH THE WRITTEN CONSENT TO THE LICENSE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from Art. 58A, § 10.

Present Art. 58A, § 10 implies that a licensee returns the license to the Commissioner so that the Commissioner, if the Commissioner chooses, can attach written consent.

11-212. ANNUAL REPORTS.

(A) REPORTS BY LICENSEES.

(1) TO ENABLE THE COMMISSIONER TO DETERMINE THE GENERAL CONDITION OF THE CONSUMER LOAN BUSINESS, EACH LICENSEE SHALL FILE WITH THE COMMISSIONER, ON OR BEFORE MARCH 1 OF EACH YEAR, AN ANNUAL REPORT THAT:

(I) IS ON THE FORM THAT THE COMMISSIONER REQUIRES;

(II) CONTAINS THE INFORMATION RELEVANT TO THE BUSINESS AND OPERATIONS OF THE LICENSEE THAT THE COMMISSIONER REQUIRES; AND

(III) IS SIGNED AND VERIFIED BY THE LICENSEE.
