11-411. CHANGE OF PLACE OF BUSINESS.

(A) NOTICE REQUIRED.

IF A LICENSEE CHANGES THE PLACE OF BUSINESS, THE LICENSEE IMMEDIATELY SHALL ~~NOTIFY SEND~~ THE COMMISSIONER ~~IN WRITING~~ THE LICENSE AND WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE CHANGE.

(B) ENDORSEMENT OF CHANGE.

~~(1)~~ ON RECEIVING NOTICE UNDER THIS SECTION, THE COMMISSIONER, WITHOUT CHARGE, SHALL ~~SEND THE LICENSEE ATTACH TO THE LICENSE~~ AN ENDORSEMENT STATING THE CHANGE AND ITS DATE.

~~(2) THE LICENSEE SHALL ATTACH THE ENDORSEMENT TO THE LICENSE.~~

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from Art. 83, § 158(b).

Subsection (a)(1) of this section is revised to clarify present Art. 83, § 158(b), which implies that a licensee sends the license to the Commissioner so the Commissioner can attach a record of the change to the license.

The present statement that the endorsement authorizes the licensee to operate the business at the new location is deleted as unnecessary.

11-412. VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF LICENSE.

(A) SURRENDER.

A LICENSEE MAY SURRENDER THE LICENSE BY DELIVERING TO THE COMMISSIONER A WRITTEN STATEMENT THAT THE LICENSE IS SURRENDERED.

(B) LIABILITY NOT AFFECTED.

THE SURRENDER OF A LICENSE DOES NOT AFFECT ANY CIVIL OR CRIMINAL LIABILITY OF THE LICENSEE FOR ACTS COMMITTED BEFORE THE LICENSE WAS SURRENDERED.
