- (2) Each member of the board serves a term of 4 years, provided, however, that those members serving on the board of license commissioners on July 1, 1979, shall serve the remainder of their terms; any later appointment shall conform to the above stated length of service.
- (3) Not more than three members of the board shall be members of the same political party.
- (4) The board annually shall elect one of its members as chairman.
- (5) Three members of the board constitute a quorum for transacting business. At least three members who are present at the BUSINESS--meeting VOTING SESSION must concur in the approval, denial, revocation, suspension, or reclassification of an alcoholic beverage license.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.

CHAPTER 56

(Senate Bill 980)

AN ACT concerning

Washington County - State's Attorney

FOR the purpose of permitting the State's Attorney for Washington County to appoint an additional assistant State's Attorney until a certain time; and providing that the salary of the assistant State's Attorney is as determined by the county commissioners.
