- (b) (1) The liquor control board may borrow money from time to time from any banking institution on its own credit.
- (2) The aggregate sum advanced to or borrowed by the liquor control board may not exceed [\$5,000 in Somerset County, \$75,000 in Harford County, \$20,000 in Kent County, \$25,000 in Wicomico County and \$200,000 in Worcester County] THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS:
  - (I) HARFORD COUNTY \$75,000
  - (II) KENT COUNTY \$20,000
  - (III) SOMERSET COUNTY \$5,000
  - (IV) WICOMICO COUNTY \$25,000
  - (V) WORCESTER COUNTY \$300,000.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.
