SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

342.

- (f) (1) A person convicted of theft where the property or services that was the subject of the theft has a value of \$300 or greater is guilty of a felony and shall restore the property taken to the owner or pay him the value of the property or services, and be fined not more than \$1,000, or be imprisoned for not more than 15 years, or be both fined and imprisoned in the discretion of the court.
- (2) A person convicted of theft where the property or services that was the subject of the theft has a value of less than \$300 is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall restore the property taken to the owner or pay him the value of the property or services, and be fined not more than [\$100] \$500, or be imprisoned for not more than 18 months, or be both fined and imprisoned in the discretion of the court; however, all actions or prosecutions for theft where the property or services that was the subject of the theft has a value of less than \$300 shall be commenced within 2 years after the commission of the offense.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.
