CHAPTER 91

(House Bill 751)

AN ACT concerning

Worcester County - Alcoholic Beverages
(License Commissioners' Salaries)

FOR the purpose of altering the salaries of the chairman and members of the Board of License Commissioners in Worcester County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
Section 155(w)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1976 Replacement Volume and 1979 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

155.

(w) In Worcester County, the chairman of the board of license commissioners will receive as compensation, the sum of [\$2,000] \$2,500 per year. Each of the other two members shall receive as compensation the sum of [\$1,600] \$2,100 PER YEAR.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.
