FOR the purpose of providing for appointment, salary, and duties of an inspector for alcoholic beverages laws for the Board of License Commissioners for Worcester County; providing the inspector with certain powers; and requiring the inspector to take an oath of faithful service.

BY adding to

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages Section 158(p) Annotated Code of Maryland (1976 Replacement Volume and 1979 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

158.

- (P) (1) IN WORCESTER COUNTY THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS, WITH THE CONSENT OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, MAY APPOINT AN INSPECTOR.
- (2) (I) THE SALARY OF THE INSPECTOR SHALL BE AS PROVIDED IN THE COUNTY BUDGET.
- (II) THE DUTIES OF THE INSPECTOR SHALL BE AS SPECIFIED BY THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS, INCLUDING THE PROPER ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LAWS IN WORCESTER COUNTY.
- (3) FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LAWS, THE INSPECTOR SHALL HAVE ALL THE POWERS OF A PEACE OFFICER OR SHERIFF OF THIS STATE.
- (4) THE INSPECTOR SHALL MAKE AN OATH TO PERFORM THE DUTIES ENTRUSTED, AS PROVIDED IN ARTICLE I, SECTION 6, OF THE CONSTITUTION OF MARYLAND.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.

CHAPTER 94

(House Bill 806)
