Chapter 336 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1976 Section 2 (as amended by Chapter 49 of the Acts of 1978)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That chapter(s) of the Acts of the General Assembly be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976. It shall remain effective for a period of [four] 6 years and, at the end of June 30, [1980] 1982, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 30, 1980.
