(a) After termination of the guardianship under § 3-106 [and any deduction for the insurance fund as required by § 3-107], the court shall distribute the remaining property in accordance with Title 13 of the Estates AND TRUSTS Article of the Code, and this subtitle.

(b) The order of distribution shall be final and binding upon any person, including the absentee.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the funds that are in the Absentee Insurance Fund as of the effective date of this Act shall be transferred to the General Fund of this State.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1980.

(Senate Bill 214)

AN ACT concerning

State Board of Commissioners of Practical
Plumbing - Water Conserving Fixtures

FOR the purpose of allowing the State Board of Commissioners of Practical Plumbing to promulgate rules to enforce the usage of water conserving fixtures ~~and--to--adopt national--standards--for--the--same--in--the--State--Plumbing Code;~~ removing a requirement that a listing of certain fixtures be maintained; and allowing the State Board of Commissioners of Practical Plumbing to adopt national standards for water conserving fixtures in the State Plumbing Code.
