(M) (1) IN SOMERSET COUNTY THE CLERK OF THE COURT, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS, MAY GRANT ~~IN-THEIR-DISCRETION~~ SPECIAL LICENSES OF ANY CLASS EXCEPT MANUFACTURER'S AND WHOLESALER'S LICENSES.

(2) THE LICENSES SHALL ENTITLE THE HOLDER TO EXERCISE ANY OF THE PRIVILEGES CONFERRED BY THE RESPECTIVE CLASSES OF LICENSES AT ANY BONA FIDE ENTERTAINMENT HELD OR CONDUCTED BY ANY CLUB, SOCIETY, ASSOCIATION, OR CIVIC OR CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION CONSISTING OF AT LEAST 20 25 MEMBERS AND HAVING BEEN IN EXISTENCE FOR AT LEAST 24 CONSECUTIVE MONTHS PRECEDING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE APPLICATION FOR THE LICENSE.

(3) (I) A SPECIAL BEER OR BEER AND LIGHT WINE LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED FOR UP TO 7 CONSECUTIVE DAYS.

(II) A SPECIAL BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED FOR UP TO 14 CONSECUTIVE DAYS.

(4) (I) THE FEE FOR A SPECIAL BEER OR BEER AND LIGHT WINE LICENSE IS \$10.

(II) THE FEE FOR A SPECIAL BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE IS \$50.

(5) THE FEES SHALL BE PAID TO THE CLERK FOR THE USE OF THE COUNTY BEFORE THE LICENSE IS ISSUED.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.
