

(4) IN SOMERSET COUNTY THE HOURS SHALL BE FROM 6 A.M. TO 1 A.M. ON THE FOLLOWING DAY.

(d) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class D beer, wine and liquor license may be exercised shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight.

(2) In Baltimore City the hours shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 1 o'clock a.m.

(3) In Caroline County the hours shall be from 6 a.m. Monday through Saturday until 1 a.m. the following day (including Sunday). In Baltimore and Kent counties the hours shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 2 o'clock a.m.

(4) In Howard County the hours shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 1 o'clock a.m.

(5) IN SOMERSET COUNTY THE HOURS SHALL BE FROM 6 A.M. TO 1 A.M. ON THE FOLLOWING DAY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.

CHAPTER 143

(Senate Bill 690)

AN ACT concerning

Income Tax - Standard Deduction -
Automatic Termination

FOR the purpose of repealing the provision by which the income tax optional standard deduction reverts automatically from 13 to 10 percent.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
