Public Information - Exceptions

FOR the purpose of providing that the home address or home telephone numbers of eertain employees of the State or any agency, instrumentality or political subdivision of the State, are-net-included-within--the--definitien--ef "public--records" may not be inspected by the public, except with the permission of the person in interest or as designated by the governmental entity which employs the person; and making this Act an emergency measure.
