BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

- (c) (1) Any veteran who received an honorable discharge from the armed forces of the United States [and was a legal resident of the State of Maryland at the time of his death] shall be eligible for burial in a state veterans' cemetery, IF THE VETERAN WAS A LEGAL RESIDENT OF THE STATE FOR 20 YEARS, OR IF THE VETERAN WAS A LEGAL RESIDENT OF THE STATE WHEN THE VETERAN ENTERED THE ARMED FORCES OR WHEN THE VETERAN DIED.
- (2) THE MARYLAND VETERANS' COMMISSION MAY WAIVE THE 20-YEAR REQUIREMENT, IF, IN THE JUDGMENT OF THE COMMISSION, THERE ARE COMPELLING REASONS TO DO SO.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.

CHAPTER 154

(House Bill 294)

AN ACT concerning
