

(C) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, A PUBLIC--SERVICE--COMPANY,--AS--DEFINED--BY--SUBSECTION--2(0)--OF--ARTICLE--78--OF--THIS--CODE, THE FOLLOWING SHALL OBTAIN THE PERMISSION OF AN OWNER BEFORE ~~IT ENGAGES~~ ENGAGING IN ANY ACT SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, BUT ~~IS~~ ARE NOT REQUIRED TO OBTAIN THE PERMISSION IN WRITING OR TO DISPLAY THE WRITTEN PERMISSION AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION:

(1) A PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY AS DEFINED IN SUBSECTION 2(0) OF ARTICLE 78 OF THE CODE; AND

(2) AN EMPLOYEE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS OR ROADS BOARD OF ANY COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY, OR THE STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION, PERFORMING ROADSIDE MAINTENANCE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1980.

CHAPTER 174

(House Bill 669)

AN ACT concerning

Public Assistance to Employable Persons -
Workmen's Compensation

FOR the purpose of providing that for the purpose of the State Workmen's Compensation Law, participants in the State Workfare Program shall be considered employees; and requiring the Secretary of Human Resources to pay premiums established under that law.
