And now for this day to wit this twenty second day of Sept.
Anno Dom. 1702 this Tryall has been cont^d from late till until
this twenty second day of Sept. aft^r the sd Defendant was called
to the bar to answer the Demer. Who for plea sayth y^e he
is not guilty and for Tryall puts himself upon the Country
And the sd Recl^d Macklin doth followe &c.

Wherupon Command is given the Sher^{of} Kent County y^e he
Immediately cause to come two twelve or twelve by whom he^r he into
the Court to recognize. &c. cause as well &c. of which I precept the Sher^{of}
make retⁿ indorsed y^e he has two twelve or twelve as by the precept he
was Commanded — Viz: Thomas Compton Wm Blaylock

who being Sworn Tryed and sworn to say the Truth in y^e Demer
do say upon their oaths y^e the said John Ponder is not guilty of
y^e Demer. Which being by the Court heard and understood it is by
them considered the same day and year y^e sd John Ponder goeth
of without day and is acquitted from y^e Indict^{ment} and paying
his fees

The John Ponder being indicted as above^d for feloniously
taking and bearing away one barrow hogg of y^e price of four
hundred pounds of the best goods and Chattels of a certain Tho^s Macklin
was cleared by y^e petit Jury and acquitted as afo^r

The sd Recl^d Ponder being indicted for stealing y^e hogg afo^r
John Ponder was acquitted by y^e Court upon verdict of y^e Jury as above^d
paying his fees

And the above^d John Ponder and Recl^d Ponder were
bound by Recogn^{ition} in ten pounds to appear at next Court to be holden for
this County and John Ponder son^{ne} becomes bound as afo^r in y^e sum afo^r
