Which said Person was by Rich^d Macklin Esq^r of the Indict^m
formed into a bill which follows in these words viz:

of Kent^{sh} County upon their oaths do present John
Hazley Ser^v to Giles Bond of Kent^{sh} County Merchants for that he
the said John Hazley the Sixth day of Nov^r: Anno Dom^o 1702
at Chester upon hundred in Kent^{sh} County within the Jurisdiction
of this Court with force and arms two hogs of the price of
One hundred and twenty pounds of tobacco the proper hogs
of a Person unknown feloniously did kill take and bear
away ag^t the peace of our Sovereign ~~the King~~ and ag^t
the form of the Act of the Act of Assembly in y^e last
made and provided Macklin Esq^r of the Indict^m

Which said Bill was thus endorsed viz: Tho: What for man
and a Certⁿ fact having thereupon sh^d to y^e sh^r of the s^d Hazley
he appeared and was thereupon bound by recogn^o from cell to
Court and this cause thereupon cont^d until this twenty second day
of September anno Dom^o 1702 when the s^d Hazley being
called to the bar to make defence to his indictment: and for plea
says y^e he is not guilty of the felony and robbing imposed
upon him and for tryall puts himself upon y^e Country
and the s^d Rich^d Macklin who follows et^c: Simill^r

Whereupon Command is given the sh^r of Kent^{sh} County
That he immediately cause to come his twelve pe^r by whom

he receiv^d y^e same day and year y^e sh^r makes ret^r y^e he has her
ready twelve pe^r as by his precept he was commanded
