John Hollisworth & John Chamney of the same County Comrs of all and singular the goods & Credits of Wm Brewster late of the same County planter deceased was summoned to answer

unto John Hollisworth of the County of Prince Georges into him of five and six pence of money of England which from him he unjustly retains. And whereupon the said J. Chamney Esq. Michael Earl his Attorney at Law for the said Wm Brewster in his life time to wit the twenty first day of May Anno Domini 1698 in the County of Prince Georges within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain bond and writing obligatory sealed with his seals as his act and deed delivered and here in Court brought in whose date is the same day and year did acknowledge himself to be owing and to stand firmly bound unto the said Plaintiff his heirs & Assigns or assigns in the said sum of five pounds sixteen shillings current Money as aforesaid the said Wm Brewster himself his heirs & Assigns by the said Bond yet notwithstanding of said Wm in his life time the said sum of 95:16: Now according to the tenor of the said bond unto the said Plaintiff he did not pay altho' often demanded neither hath the said Wm in his last capacity during the death of the said Wm paid the same (altho' unto him last of London in due form of Law hath been committed) and he hath been thereunto often required but the same to pay he hath denied and refused and still doth deny and refuse and unjustly retains to the damage of the said Plaintiff 191:12: Now the money as aforesaid and thereupon he brings this Bill for the recovery of the same

And the said Defendant Mark his Bill comes and defends the force and injury whereof and prays over of the said obligation and is read unto him he also prays over of the condition of the same And it is read unto him in these words following The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Wm Brewster his heirs & Assigns shall and will save and well and truly defend and keep harmless the above named John Hollisworth his heirs & Assigns of and from all manner of Damages that shall or may accrue to him or said John Hollisworth his heirs & Assigns by virtue of a bond passed
