

pounds of like qualified tobacco as above. at or upon the tenth day of November Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and one and for the true and just performance of thereof the said Charles bound himself his heirs &c and Adm. in the sum of three thousand four hundred pounds of like qualified tobacco by the said writing obligatory yet notwithstanding the said Charles the sum of three thousand four hundred pounds of tobacco according to the tenor of the said bill obligatory unto the said plaintiff did not pay but the same to pay hath and still doth deny and refuse to the damage of the said plaintiff £800 tob. and thereupon he brings this suit *Caroli pffona plegi. In D. R. R.*

And now here at this day to wit the twenty seventh day of January Anno Domini 1708 comes the said Charles Loder in his proper person into open Court and saith that as to the sum of seventeen hundred pounds of tobacco the principal debt in the debt mentioned he cannot say but that it is justly due unto the said Daniel and is therefore willing that judgment be entered against him for the same. Whereupon the said Daniel in open Court releases unto him the penalty of the same bill.

It is therefore considered by the Court here this twenty seventh day of January Anno Domini 1709 that the said Daniel recover of the said Charles Loder as well the sum of seventeen hundred pounds of tobacco the debt aforesaid as also the sum of two hundred and forty five pounds of tobacco cost of suit and of. def. in Mercy &c.

County gent was summoned to answer unto Michael Carle one of the Attorneys of said County Court according to the liberties and privileges accustomed of the plea that he render unto him the full and just sum of four and twenty hundred pounds of good sound merchantable tobacco and carry which to him he oweth and from him unjustly detains and whereupon the said Michael in his own proper person in prosecution of the aforesaid saith that whereas the said James on the twelfth day of January Anno Domini 1700 in D. County within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain bill or writing obligatory sealed with his seal as his act and deed delivered and now in Court brought whose date is the same day and year did bind himself his heirs &c and Adm. to pay or cause to be paid unto the aforesaid Michael the said sum of four hundred pounds of tobacco qualified as aforesaid convenient in Chester river at or upon the tenth day of October next following the date of the same bill yet notwithstanding the said James the said sum of two thousand four hundred pounds of tobacco according to the tenor of the same bill unto the said Michael he hath not paid altho often demanded but the same to pay he hath done and refused and still doth deny and refuse and unjustly detains to the damage of the said Michael £4800. tob. and thereupon he brings this suit *Caroli pffona plegi. In D. R. R.*

And the said James Dooergoe the def. in his own proper person comes to defend the force and injury whereof and prays leave hereof to impart
