this twelfth second day of Sept. Anno Dom. 1702 that the said Sam:  
Taylor recover ag: the said Robert Hawkshaw as well the sum  
of four hundred and eight pounds of tobacco the rest of the sum  
of three hundred and fifty three pounds of tobacco left of  
said and the defend: in money &c:

Goffry Power John Shaw att dit John Shaw of Coll County was summoned  
to answer unto Goffry Power of a plea of trespass  
John Shaw the sum of eight hundred pounds and five pounds of tobacco  
in cases which to him he oweth and from him unjustly detain

As of the Debt and Bill filed in this Court by Richard Macklin Attorney of  
the plaintiff May now at large appears  
And the said S<sup>r</sup> by Mr. Earl his atty appears and prays:  
leave to inspect until next Court and he hath it the same day  
given the plaintiff also. At which said next Court comes the said S<sup>r</sup>  
by his atty and the said Michael Earl attys ag: who sayth up:  
he is not informed by his client of any sufficient Matter or thing  
to plead in barr of the action ag: so as ag: brought up of y:  
said Goffry Power remains ag: the said John Shaw altogether  
undefended.

It is therefore considered by the Justices here this twelfth second  
day of September Anno Dom. 1702 that the said Goffry Power recover  
ag: the said John Shaw as well the sum of eight hundred pounds  
and five pounds of tobacco up: the rest of the sum of three  
hundred and twenty one pounds of tobacco left of said of  
S<sup>r</sup> in money &c:

John Smith vs Thomas Hawkins att dit Thomas Hawkins of Chester  
County in Kent County in the province of Maryland planter  
was summoned to answer unto John Smith of a plea  
that he render him the full and just sum of one thousand  
four hundred and seventy four pounds of tobacco good sound  
and merchantable for cases clear from all manner of ground  
leaves and trash which to him he oweth and from him he  
unjustly detain. As of y: debt and account bill filed in this Court  
by Richard Macklin atty of the ptf May appears and the  
S<sup>r</sup> by Michael Earl his atty comes and says the force and  
injury when &c: and prays leave to inspect persons  
until next Court and he hath it up: sameday is given the plaintiff  
also. At which said next Court to wit this twelfth second

day
