Mich. Perry & John West at deit John West of Kent County planter was summoned to answer unto Mich. Perry & John West of the said County of Kent. Mich. Perry and John Debarbush in Comp. March of a plea of the debt aforesaid the full and just sum of two thousand pounds of tobacco good sound and very well conditioned tobacco in Cases which he hath from his owne and from them he unjustly detains as by the debt filed in this Court by Rich. Macklin atty of the plaintiff may at large appear. And the said Defendant in his proper person comes into Court & says that he cannot gainsay the said declaration for as yet he hath brought nor but that he is and stands justly indebted to the plaintiff in the sum aforesaid and is therefore if Judge be ordered.

It is therefore considered by the Justices here this twenty second day of Sept. Anno Domini 1702 that the said Mich. Perry & Comp. recover against the said John West as well the sum of two thousand pounds of tobacco the debt aforesaid as the sum of two hundred and seventy five pounds of tobacco off of suit and the cost in Money.
