Do. R. Ho

And the said Defend^t this Twenty fifth day of Nov^r Anno Dom. 1701 By Michael Earle his Attorney comes and defends the foresaid and injury when he prayes leave to imparle herinto until next Court which is granted him the same day is given the p^l also =

All which said next Court to wit the twenty seventh day of Jan^y Anno Dom. 1701 Comes the said plaint^t by his attorney aforesaid and prayeth that the Defendant to his deed may answer. But the said Defend^t altho' solemnly called Cometh not in his proper person nor by his Attorney to make defence to the deed aforesaid but makes default. So that the plaint^t Remains ag^t the said Defend^t wholly undefended.

Which being by the Court understood it is by them considered that the twenty seventh day of January aforesaid that the said Charles Hollisworth Recover ag^t the said Isaac Cault the do^r. as well the Summe of Eleven pounds current and Lawfull Money of England the do^r aforesaid as the Summe of two hundred and forty five pounds of tob^o.
